DATE/DATE\$

Format

CALL DATE("mm/dd/yy")
DATE\$

Description

DATE\$ can be a function.

CALL DATE can be a statement or a command.

It can be used to set the date or retrieve the current date.

To set the date use the format:

CALL DATE("mm/dd/yy")

mm is the two-digit equivalent of the current month 01-12

dd is the two digit date 01-31

yy is the last two digits. Two-digit range= range 01-99

To retrieve the current date, use the function DATE\$.

Example

CALL DATE("01/01/87")

This example sets the date to January 1, 1987

Example

PRINT DATE\$

01/01/87

Example
